

VISION PLUS' PATIENT CHECK LIST

As a valued patient to our practice, we would like to thank you for choosing Vision Plus to provide your eye health and vision care needs. In order for us to establish your medical file and provide the most beneficial use of your time with us, the doctor has asked that you check the following list for the items that apply to you and bring the checked items to your appointment. It is important that we have this information to help address any significant issues during your visit.

___ **Welcome to the Office with Office Policy, Privacy Acknowledgement Form, etc.**

This diagnostic information includes personal and family information, and completed medical and eye health history. Since many general health conditions may be associated with visual symptoms and/or eye health problems, this important information (now required by state health boards, and medical and optical insurance plans) will allow us to care for you as a “whole person” rather than just a pair of eyes.

___ **Current Medications.** There is, also, a section for the type of medications you are taking. Please include both prescription and non-prescription. It may be easier to attach a separate sheet listing all your medications if you are taking numerous meds.

___ **Insurance Card(s).** It is important to bring your insurance card(s) with you. If a medical condition is discovered during the comprehensive eye health examination, the doctor can determine the treatment regimen and have the claim filed to your medical health insurance.

___ **Eyeglasses.** Please bring all pairs of eyeglasses you currently use including non-prescription reading glasses, sunglasses, etc. We have instruments to compare the optical power of your old lenses with your new exam findings thus enabling the doctor to determine and explain how your vision has changed over time.

___ **Contact Lenses.** If at all possible, it is recommended that you **do not** wear your contact lenses to your appointment. Please specify the contact lens solution you are currently using: _____.

___ **Eye Drops, Ointments, etc.** Please bring any eye drops or eye ointments that you use to your appointment. The doctor will review whether these are appropriate, and if a better option is recommended.

___ **Dilation Explained.** The doctor will use drops to dilate your eyes to fully evaluate their internal health. This will cause sensitivity to light and “fuzzy” vision at your near (reading) distance. For eyewear purchase, feel free to come in 15 to 20 minutes before your appointment to look at our wide selection of designer frames.
